## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Defining Mental Illness for Public Assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 22, § 3301, sub-§ 4, amended. Subsection 4 of section 3301 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

"Disabled" also means an indigent individual suffering from psychosis or neurosis."

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 22, § 3742, amended. Section 3742 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'Aid to dependent children shall be granted if the parent or relative with whom the child is living is an indigent individual suffering from psychosis or neurosis.'
