## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Right to Hold Property of Corporations for Facilities for Elderly Persons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 13, § 932, amended. The first paragraph of section 932 of Title 13 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

'Any corporation organized under this chapter for the purpose of establishing, maintaining and conducting housing or similar facilities for use of the elderly on a nonprofit basis may receive and hold real or personal estate to any amount which may from time to time be purchased, given, granted, bequeathed or devised to it, and accepted by said corporation for such uses for the benefit of such elderly or aged individuals.'
