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**AN ACT Relating to Operation of Homemaker Service by Department of Health and Welfare.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 22, § 3106, additional.** Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 3106, to read as follows:

**§ 3106. Operation of homemaker service**

The department is authorized to establish and operate a homemaker service and to make grants to assist in developing homemaker services by local agencies approved by the department. The department shall promulgate rules and regulations to establish the standards for approval of local agencies for receiving such grants for developing homemaker services.'

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$40,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$60,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
