**AN ACT Relating to Time of Keeping Open Turnpike Exit to Scarborough
Downs.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 308, additional. Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 308 to read as follows:

‘§ 308. Scarborough exit on turnpike

During the racing season at Scarborough Downs, Turnpike Exit 6 shall remain open from 8 a.m. to midnight.’
