## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Providing for a Uniform Deer Hunting Season.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2353, amended. The 6th paragraph of section 2353 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'There shall be an open season on deer in each calendar year in the zones described as follows:

Northern Zone: Beginning on the 3rd Saturday in October and continuing through the 6th Saturday following.

Central Zone: Beginning on the 4th Saturday of October and continuing through the 6th Saturday following.

Southeastern Zone: Beginning on the first Saturday of November and continuing through the 6th Saturday following.

Southwestern Zone: Beginning on the first Saturday of November and continuing through the 6th Saturday following.'
