STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Power Boats on North Pond, Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 242, additional. Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 242, to read as follows:

'§ 242. North Pond

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to use motors on watercraft, in and upon the waters of North Pond, so-called, situated within the boundaries of the Towns of Buckfield and Sumner, Oxford County.'
