STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Sanity Examination of Accused Persons in the District Court and Expenses of Blood Tests in Drunken Driving Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 168, amended. The last sentence of section 168 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The cost of such examination shall be paid from the **State Treasury** ~~of the county in which the action is pending.~~'

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 1312, amended. The 7th sentence of section 1312 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'All such tests made to determine the weight of alcohol in the blood shall be paid for by the ~~county wherein the violation of this section was alleged to have occurred~~ **State.**'

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$180,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$180,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
