SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 347,

L. D. 1114, Bill, "An Act Relating to Retirement of Justices
of the Supreme Judicial Court and Superior Court."

Amend said Amendment by striking out everything after the Title
and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Amend said Bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble
and the emergency clause.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the
General Fund the sum of \$8,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30,
1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall
be as follows:

All Other	\$8,500 ' "
