SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 349, L. D. 1115, Bill, "An Act
Requiring All Municipalities to Join School Administrative
Districts by 1970."

Amend said Bill in the last paragraph by inserting after the
first underlined sentence a new underlined sentence to read as
follows: 'Such a master plan shall consider the role of the
private secondary schools serving the municipalities of a given area
in the education of secondary school pupils. The board shall consult
with the trustees of each private secondary school as to the
possible future role of the private school in the development of an
adequate-sized school district in a given geographical area.'
