SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 349, L. D. 1115, Bill, "An Act
Requiring all Municipalities to Join School Administrative
Districts by 1970."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and
inserting in place thereof the following: "An Act Relating to
Municipalities Joining School Administrative Districts."

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

" 'The board shall, after a master plan for school administrative
district organization is presented to the 103rd Legislature, as ordered
in Senate Paper 453 of the 102nd Legislature and accepted by the 103rd
Legislature as presented or with modifications, approve the formation
of School Administrative Districts only in accordance with the plan
as adopted. It further is the intent of the Legislature that all
municipalities with fewer than 500 resident high school pupils and
not in School Administrative Districts shall, within a reasonable
time after adoption of the master plan for school administrative
district organization, join into School Administrative Districts in
accordance with that master plan.' "
