AN ACT Relating to Trespass on Lands of the University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 3851, amended. Section 3851 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 3851. Lands appurtenant to state institutions

Whoever willfully trespasses upon lands which belong to the State and are appurtenant to the Pineland Hospital and Training Center, Reformatory for Women, Reformatory for Men, Stevens Training Center, Boys Training Center or the Maine State Prison, or whoever shall unlawfully interfere with the inmates of any of said institutions, or, **whoever willfully trespasses upon land or buildings of the University of Maine**, after notice from an officer of any of said institutions **or the University of Maine** to leave said lands **or buildings**, remains thereon, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 or by imprisonment for not more than 3 months.'
