COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 360, L. D. 1122, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Labeling of Imported Meats Sold in Retail  
Stores."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 3rd underlined  
paragraph from the end and inserting in place thereof the  
following:

'No person, firm, corporation or society shall sell or  
offer for sale hamburg or ground beef made from imported frozen  
meat in a retail or wholesale outlet unless there is posted on or  
adjacent thereto a sign made of letters not less than 2 inches in  
height stating that the product displayed or offered for sale has  
been manufactured wholly or in part from frozen meat imported from  
.....'
