AN ACT to Provide for Partial Discontinuance of Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 2347-A, additional. Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2347-A to read as follows:

‘§ 2347-A. Discontinuance of public ways

In proceedings for the discontinuance of public ways, such public ways may be discontinued in whole or in part. Unless an order discontinuing the same shall specifically otherwise provide, a utility may continue to maintain, repair and replace its installations within the limits of such way until such installations shall be discontinued or abandoned, and such way shall continue for such purpose.’
