COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 366, L. D. 1133, Bill,

"An Act Relating to Credit for Military Service Under
State Retirement Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 8
underlined lines and inserting in place thereof the following:
"5% of the earnable compensation paid such member as a teacher,
state employee or participating district employee during the
first year of employment subsequent to service in the armed
forces, plus such interest amounts as provided under section
1094, subsections 8, 9 and 10. Credit for military service
under this subsection shall be limited to 4 years. Such
credit shall be available to those persons who were separated
under conditions other than dishonorable from the Armed Forces
of the United States. This subsection shall be made available
to those who have retired and desire to make the necessary
contributions."
