STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Revising the Motor Vehicle Dealer Registration Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 331, amended. The 4th sentence from the end of section 331 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'The Secretary of State shall furnish the applicant with 2 registration plates for a fee of \$25 each and 2 similar plates for a fee of \$10 each.'

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 331, amended. Section 331 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, 2 new paragraphs, as follows:

'To qualify as a dealer in new motor vehicles for the purposes of this Title, said dealer must have sold 10 motor vehicles for each dealer plate assigned to him during the previous year in order to renew said dealer plates.

To qualify as a dealer in used motor vehicles for the purposes of this Title, said dealer must have sold 10 motor vehicles for each used car dealer plate assigned to him during the previous year in order to renew said used car dealer plates.'

- Sec. 3. R. S., T. 29, § 332, sub-§ 3, additional. Section 332 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 3, to read as follows:
- '3. Use. Holders of transporter plates may use them for demonstration purposes on the type of equipment for which they are registered.'
- Sec. 4. R. S., T. 29, § 332-A, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 332-A, to read as follows:
- '§ 332-A. Repairer registration plates; application; fees

- 1. Application. All persons operating a motor vehicle repair or body shop and not actually engaged in the buying and selling of motor vehicles may make application for a repairer plate for the purpose of movement of motor vehicles from an owner's location to such shop and return.
- 2. Fees. Repairer plates shall be issued for the uses provided for a fee of \$25 each for the first 3 plates and \$10 for each additional plate.'
