SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 371, L. D. 1138, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Operation of Motorcycles While Learning to
Drive."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause, the
following section:

"Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, §532, amended. Section 532 of Title
29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new
paragraph, as follows:

'Any person holding a valid driver's license and who is at
least 17 years of age shall be issued a temporary permit for a
period of one year to operate a motorcycle until he passes his
road test. The fee for the road test shall be \$2.'"

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of
the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.''
