IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Operation of Motorcycles While Learning to Drive.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 537, amended. Section 537 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘Any unlicensed person while learning to operate a motorcycle shall not carry any passenger on said motorcycle who is not licensed as a motorcycle operator.’
