COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 356, L. D. 1140, Bill, "An Act Affecting Certain Statutes Pertaining to Court Process and Procedure in Criminal Cases and to Kindred Matters."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined sentence of that part designated "§931." of section 40 and inserting in place thereof the following:

"The obligation of the principal and any sureties may then be enforced by motion in the court in which the bail was posted or in the Superior Court in the same county, in such manner as the Supreme Judicial Court shall by rule provide."
