# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Restoration to Service Under State Retirement Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 5, § 1123, amended.** The 3rd sentence of section 1123 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is repealed, as follows:

'Should any recipient of benefits other than disability benefits be restored to service, the same general limitations with respect to whether or not the benefits should be suspended will be as outlined above, except that in the event benefits are suspended during such period of employment and such member subsequently again retires, he shall receive such combined benefits as may be computed on his entire creditable service and in accordance with the then existing law.'
