COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 850, L.D. 1149, Bill, "An Act Relating to Suspension of Lobster License for Molesting Lobster Traps."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 7th line and inserting in place thereof the following:

"~~not-to-exceed~~ of 3 years."

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

"Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, §3752, sub-§5, amended. The first sentence of subsection 5 of section 3752 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows: 'Any person whose license, permit or right thereto has been suspended under subsections ~~1~~, 2, 3 or 4 may request the commissioner for a hearing.'
