IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Suspension of Lobster License for Molesting Lobster Traps.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 12, § 3752, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 3752 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- '1. **Exception.** On conviction of a violation of section 4457, the commissioner may shall suspend the offender's lobster and crab fishing license and may shall suspend his right to obtain such a license for a period not to exceed 3 years.'
