STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Persons Liable for Poll Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 1381, amended. Section 1381 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'§ 1381. Amount; persons liable

A poll tax of 33 shall be assessed upon every male resident of the State between the ages of 21 and 7065 years, whether a citizen of the United States or an alien, in the place where he resides on the first day of each April, unless he is exempted therefrom by this Title. No person shall be considered a resident of a place merely on account of being present there as a student in an educational institution.'
