## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Limiting Number of Deputy Sheriffs in Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 951, amended. Section 951 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'The number of deputies for Kennebec County shall be no more than 50, including any special deputies that may be appointed.'
