STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Width of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1701, amended. Section 1701 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the first sentence 2 new sentences to read as follows:

'The operations on any way or bridge of this State of any vehicle loaded entirely with firewood, pulpwood, logs or bolts shall not be deemed to be in violation of this section if the width of such vehicle does not exceed 110% of the maximum allowed by this section. Nothing contained in the 2nd sentence shall permit, validate or in any way apply to the use of the Interstate System as defined in the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1956.'
