AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Clerk and Assistant Clerk of the House of Representatives.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 3, § 42, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 42 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'He shall receive a salary of ~~\$5,000~~ \$9,000 for the year in which the Legislature is in regular session and a salary of ~~\$1,000~~ \$3,000 for the a year in which when the Legislature is not in regular session.'

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 3, § 42, amended. The last paragraph of section 42 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The assistant clerk of the House of Representatives shall receive a salary of ~~\$2,800~~ \$5,000. His work shall be performed under the direction of the clerk.'
