AN ACT Establishing Daily Limit on White Perch in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. R. S., T. 12, § 2553, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 2553 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'No person shall take, kill or have in possession more than 25 white perch taken from the waters of Kennebec ~~and~~, Somerset **and** Washington Counties and Boyd Lake in Piscataquis County except as provided by rules and regulations of the department under section 1960.'

Sec. 2. Limitation. This Act shall remain in effect only until January 1, 1967.
