AN ACT Relating to Equal Pay for Women Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 628, amended. The first sentence of section 628 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'No employer shall employ any female in any occupation within this State for salary or wage rates less than the salary or wage rates paid by that employer to male employees for equal **or comparable** work.'
