STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Petition for Release of Respondents Acquitted on Basis of Mental Defect.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 15, § 104, amended. Section 104 of Title 15 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph after the first paragraph, to read as follows:

'Upon a petition for release of a person committed under section 103, the Superior Court or any justice thereof may, at the expense of the State, obtain an independent psychiatric examination of the respondent.'
