COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 381, L. D. 1197, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Driving a Vehicle to Endanger."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., T. 29, §1314, repealed and replaced. Section 1314 of
Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following
enacted in place thereof:

'§1314. Driving to endanger

No person shall recklessly drive any vehicle upon a way in
such a manner as to endanger the safety of any person or property.'"
