STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Catching Lobsters by Skindivers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 4453, sub-§ 3, additional. Section 4453 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 3, to read as follows:

'3. Exception if lobsters caught by skindivers. It shall be lawful for skindivers, as that term is commonly used, to catch up to, but not exceeding, 10 lobsters per day by hand without the assistance of catching instruments of any kind for noncommercial purposes only.'
