**AN ACT Relating to Expenses and Travel of County Commissioners of
Aroostook County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 106, amended. The last paragraph of section 106 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Said salaries shall be in full for all services, expenses and travel to and from the county seat, including the management of the jails and workshops and the sale of their products, **except that the county commissioners of Aroostook County shall receive their expenses and travel to and from the county seat and** except that when outside of the county seat on official business, including public hearings, inspection and supervising construction, snow removal and maintenance of roads in unincorporated townships in their respective counties, they shall be allowed all necessary traveling and hotel expenses connected therewith. All bills for such expenses shall be approved by the clerk of courts and the county attorney of their county and paid by the treasurer of said county and with the further exception of such expenses as are provided for in section 55.'
