COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 925, L.D. 1215, Bill,
"An Act Providing for Registration of Land Surveyors."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§1662" of
section 1 by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A civil engineer who is a graduate of an accredited school
of civil engineering or a forester who is a graduate of an
accredited school of forestry or who has been employed as a
forester for the last 5 years in the State of Maine may practice
land surveying without registration as a land surveyor.'
