IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT Relating to Time of Ordering Liquor by Certain Licensees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 28, § 55, sub-§ 7, amended. Subsection 7 of section 55 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- '7. Licensing. To issue and renew all licenses provided for by this Title and to hold hearings thereon. Prospective licensees who have been granted a license, effective at a future date, may, on approval of the commission, order liquor in advance of the effective date of the license.'
