IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Authorizing Expenditure from Funds of Passamaquoddy Tribe for
Legal Services to Protect Lands.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 4714, amended. Section 4714 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

‘A sum not exceeding \$5,000 may be expended by the Governor and Council from the funds of the Passamaquoddy Tribe for legal services incidental to the protection of its tribal lands.’
