IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Closing State Liquor Stores and Licensees in Case of
Riots, Hurricanes and Floods.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 28, § 156, additional. Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 156, to read as follows:

‘§ 156. Closed in cases of riots, etc.

The Governor may, in cases of riots, hurricanes and floods, order the state liquor stores to be closed for a period not exceeding 5 days at any one time.’

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 28, § 205, additional. Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 205, to read as follows:

‘§ 205. Closed in cases of riots, etc.

The Governor may, in cases of riots, hurricanes and floods, order licensees not to sell any liquor for a period not exceeding 5 days at any one time. Any licensee who sells liquor in violation of this section shall have his license revoked.’
