AN ACT Relating to Inequities in Subsidies to School Administrative Units.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 3724, additional. Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 3724, to read as follows:

‘§ 3724. Inequities

Whenever the present school subsidy formula as provided in this chapter creates an inequity to a school administrative unit, the school board of that school administrative unit shall have the right to appeal to the Governor and Council in the manner prescribed by said Governor and Council. After review of the alleged inequity, if the Governor and Council conclude that an inequity does in fact exist, the Governor and Council may increase the allocation of that school administrative unit's subsidy, notwithstanding the said subsidy formula, to an equitable amount.’
