STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing for an Interchange to the Maine Turnpike from the Town of Old Orchard Beach.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 308, additional. Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 308, to read as follows:

‘§ 308. Turnpike interchange

The Maine Turnpike Authority shall construct an interchange necessary to provide reasonable access to the Maine Turnpike from the Town of Old Orchard Beach.’
