AN ACT Relating to Closed Season on Bears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2355-A, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2355-A to read as follows:

‘§ 2355-A. Closed time on bears

There shall be a closed season for the hunting or trapping of black bear during the months of January and February of each year in the unorganized territory.’
