## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Legal Length of Salmon Taken from Sebago Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 12, § 2553, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 2553 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 'I. Salmon or togue. A salmon or togue less than 14 inches in length except that the length limit on salmon taken from any of the waters in Aroostook County or from Sebago Lake, Cumberland County, shall be 12 inches;'
