### **AN ACT Providing for an Additional District Court Judge for District 10.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 4, § 157, amended.** The first 2 sentences of section 157 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

'The Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, shall appoint to the District Court 2 judges at large and ~~14~~ 15 judges. At least one judge shall be appointed in each district who shall be a resident thereof, except that in District 9 and District 10 there shall be 2 judges appointed who shall be residents ~~thereof~~ of their respective districts.'
