AN ACT Requiring Landowner's Permission to Trap Beaver.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2360-A, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2360-A, to read as follows:

‘§ 2360-A. Landowner's permission to trap beaver

In order to provide for the storage of water, create ponds for fire protection and to construct dams for flood control, it shall be unlawful to trap beaver without the landowner's permission.’
