## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Legal Fees in Court Proceeding for Benefits Under Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 1044, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 1044 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting before the last sentence, a new sentence, as follows:

'In the event a claimant has retained such counsel for the purpose of representation in a court proceeding, and the final decision of such court results in a reversal, in whole or in part, of the decision appealed from, the fees for such service shall be paid by the commission.'
