SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 848, L. D. 1261, Bill, "An Act Relating to Repeal of Sardine Tax on Exports."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., T. 32, §4157, amended. The last 4 sentences of the first paragraph of section 4157 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes are repealed, as follows:

~~'When less than 5 fish are packed in a 1/4 size keyless can, there shall be plainly and permanently lithographed thereon in letters and numerals not less than 1/8 inch in height a statement clearly indicating that the contents are 4 fish or 4 sardines and the packer shall not offer such cans for sale,--It shall be unlawful to place covers indicating the contents as 4 fish or 4 sardines on cans containing more than 4 fish,--The shipping containers used for cans which indicate the contents as 4 fish or 4 sardines shall be plainly and conspicuously marked with letters no less than 1/2 inch in height with the words 4-FISH-CANS,--It shall be unlawful to place cans containing more than 4 fish in shipping containers marked with the words 4-FISH-CANS.'~~"

Further amend said Bill by renumbering the sections of the Bill to read consecutively.
