SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 848, L. D. 1261, Bill, "An Act Relating to Repeal of Sardine Tax on Exports."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., T. 32, §4157, amended. The last 4 sentences of the first paragraph of section 4157 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes are repealed, as follows:

'When-less-than-5-fish-are-packed-in-a-l/4-size-keyless-can,-there
shall-be-plainly-and-permanently-lithegraphed-thereon-in-letters-and
numerals-not-less-than-l/8-inch-in-height-a-statement-clearly-indicating-that-the-centents-are-4-fish-or-4-sardines-and-the-packer-shallse-effer-such-cans-for-sale,--It-shall-be-unlawful-to-place-covers
indicating-the-centents-as-4-fish-or-4-sardines-en-cans-containing
more-than-4-fish,--The-shipping-centainers-used-for-cans-which
indicate-the-centents-as-4-fish-or-4-sardines-shall-be-plainly-and
conspicuously-marked-with-letters-no-less-than-l/2-inch-in-height
with-the-words-4-FISH-CANS,--It-shall-be-unlawful-to-place-cans-centaining-more-than-4-fish-in-shipping-centainers-marked-with-the-words-4-FISH-CANS,'"

Further amend said Bill by renumbering the sections of the Bill to read consecutively.
