AN ACT Creating Facility Improvement Fund for Certain Recipients of Stipend Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 7, § 62, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 62 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'One-half of the amounts contributed under Title 8, sections 274 and 333, shall be placed in a facility improvement fund. ~~Three-fourths of the facility improvement fund shall be~~ divided for reimbursements in equal amounts to each recipient of the Stipend Fund which conducts pari-mutuel racing in conjunction with its annual fair if said recipient has improved its ~~racing~~ facilities and has met the standards for facility improvements set by the commissioner for said recipients.'

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 7, § 62, amended. Section 62 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the 2nd sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

'One-fourth of the facility improvement fund shall be divided for reimbursement to recipients of the Stipend Fund which do not conduct pari-mutuel racing, in the proportion that the premiums paid by a fair not conducting pari-mutuel racing bears to the total premiums paid by all fairs not conducting pari-mutuel racing, if said recipient has improved its facilities and has met the standards for facility improvements set by the Commissioner of Agriculture for such recipients.'

Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall become effective January 1, 1966.
