STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Defining Public Utility in Relation to Certain Sewer Districts and Systems.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 15, sub-§ 13, amended. Subsection 13 of section 15 of Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Sewer districts and every other person, firm, corporation and association owning, controlling or managing any sewer system for compensation shall not be deemed to be public utility. Notwithstanding any private and special Acts of the Legislature contrary thereto, the rates, services, practices or any other matters including but not limited to the acquisition of property, construction, maintenance and financing of such sewer systems shall not be subject to nor regulated by the Public Utilities Commission.'
