## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Increasing Property Tax Exemption for Widows of Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 36, § 653, sub-§ 1, ¶ D, amended.** The first paragraph of paragraph D of subsection 1 of section 653 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The estates up to the value of 3,500 \$7,000, having a taxable situs in the place of residence, of the unremarried widow or minor child of any veteran who would be entitled to such exemption if living, or who is in receipt of a pension or compensation from the Federal Government as the widow or minor child of a veteran.'
