STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Commissioners of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 3rd paragraph, which relates to Aroostook County, of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Aroostook County: County commissioners, \$1,250 \$1,500, except that one member of the board, designated by the board as chief administrative officer, shall receive \$5,000 \$5,500; clerk of courts, \$5,500; county attorney, \$4,500; assistant county attorney, \$3,500; county treasurer, \$3,000; sheriff, \$5,500; register of deeds, northern district, \$4,000; southern district, \$4,500; judge of probate, \$4,000; register of probate, \$4,000.'
