STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing Free Deer Hunting Season for Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2353-A, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2353-A to read as follows:

§ 2353-A. Open season on deer for veterans

There shall be an open season on deer for 14 days next preceding the open season provided by section 2353, for Maine residents who are or have performed active duty in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States during any war and who possess an unexpired hunting license or unexpired combination hunting and fishing license.'
