AN ACT to Authorize the Adoption of a System of Marking the Waters of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 323, amended. Section 323 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘The Director of the Maine State Park and Recreation Commission may make rules for the uniform marking of the water areas of this State through the placement of aids to navigation and regulatory markers. No city, county or person shall mark the waters of this State in any manner in conflict with the marking system prescribed by the Director of the Maine State Park and Recreation Commission.’
